Jane Austen was born 16<sup>th</sup> December 1775, in Hampshire in England and moved to Bath in 1800. She was an English novelist whose works were of romantic fiction and she earned a place as one of the most widely read writers in English literature with *Sense and Sensibility*, *Pride and Prejudice*, *Emma*, *Northanger Abbey*, *Persuasion* and many more.

**“They set off in good time for the Pump Room, where the ordinary course of events took place; Mr Allen, after drinking his glass of water joined some gentlemen to talk over politics of the day and compare the accounts of their news-papers; and the ladies walked about together, noticing every new face and almost every new bonnet in the room”**
