Bath Gin comes from the glorious county of Somerset and unsurprisingly, from the wonderful city of Bath.

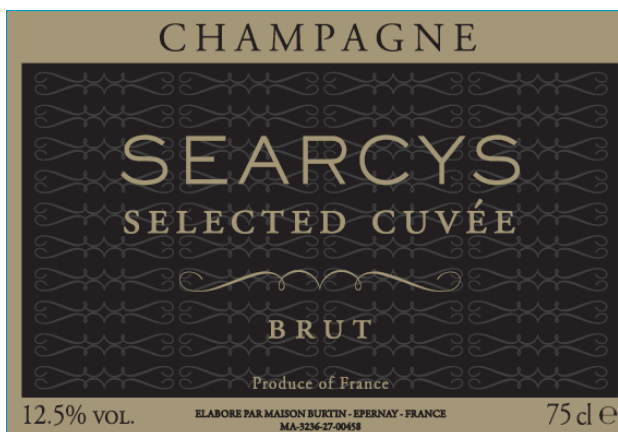
The Bath Gin Company was born from the folk at The Canary Gin Bar on Queen Street.

Bollinger

Champagne Bollinger was established in 1829 and remains independently owned and run. Madame Lilly Bollinger championed this independent house. Lilly expanded production through the purchase of vine yards, however she is better known for promoting the brand, "I drink it when I am happy and when I am sad. Some times I drink it when I'm alone; when I have company I consider it obligatory. I trifle with it when I am hungry and drink it when I am. Otherwise, I never touch it – unless I'm thirsty"

GH Mumm

Georges Hermann Mumm, a descendant of the founders, took over the company in 1853. It is considered one of the most easily recognisable houses, thanks to the vivid scarlet sash across its labels which is said to represent the ribbon of legional honneur, France's highest badge of honour. The house style is a balance of finesse and clarity and fruit. One of their most famous Champagnes, Mumm de Cramant, is made solely from chardonnay.
